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3	SECTION 2. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO	
4	CODIFY THIS SECTION.] <u>No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall</u>	
5	be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's	
6	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year	
7	amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be	
8	implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial	
9	accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years	
10	until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than	
11	the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.	
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13	SECTION 3. Emergency Clause. It is found and determined by the Eighty-	
14	third General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that deceased retirees of the	
15	Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System Leave beneficiaries in	
16	need of financial support, that there is a necessity of financial stability	
17	for beneficiaries during this time of crisis, that this benefit is then	
18	important to provide for retirees immediately, and that this act should	
19	therefore have immediate effect. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist	
20	and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public	
21	peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by	
22	the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it	
23	shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which	
24	the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the	
25	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house	
26	overrides the veto.	
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
