20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF	THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-4-520	is amended to read as follows:	
23	24-4-520. Termination required for retirement.		
24	(a) A member of the Arkansas Publi	c Employees' Retirement System must	
25	terminate covered employment to be eligib	le for retirement.	
26	(b) A member shall not be terminat	ed from employment for retirement	
27	purposes if the person <del>returns to a posit</del>	ion that would otherwise be covered	
28	3 within thirty (30) days of the person's o	ffective date of retirement:	
29	(1) Returns to employment in	a position covered under the system	
30	within thirty (30) days of the person's e	ffective date of retirement; or	
31	(2) Is a member with service	credit under § 24-3-301 at a rate of	
32	two (2) or more years of credited service	for each year of actual service and	
33	the person returns to employment in a pos	ition covered under the system within	
34	ninety (90) days of the person's effective	<u>e date of retirement</u> .	
35	(c) Persons failing to meet termin	(c) Persons failing to meet termination requirements shall forfeit

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2	SECTION 2. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO	
3	CODIFY THIS SECTION.] <u>No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall</u>	
4	be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's	
5	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year	
6	amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be	
7	implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial	
8	accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years	
9	until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than	
10	the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.	
11		
12	SECTION 3. Emergency Clause. It is found and determined by the General	
13	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the thirty-day requirement for	
14	termination of employment applies to all members of the Public Employees'	
15	Retirement System; that members of the retirement system earn service credit	
16	at different rates; that the same requirement for termination of employment is	
17	inequitable and this change must be implemented to correct that inequity; and	
18	this act should therefore have immediate effect. Therefore an emergency is	
19	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the	
20	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on	
21	the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor	
22	vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the	
23	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is	
24	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective	
25	on the date the last house overrides the veto.	
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
