For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-301(a)(1) TO PROVIDE THAT THE SENATE SHALL SELECT SIXTEEN SENATE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL IN A MANNER PRESCRIBED BY SENATE RULES; TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 10-3-403(a)(1)(A) TO PROVIDE THAT FOUR SENATE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING COMMITTEE SHALL BE SELECTED FROM EACH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT BY CAUCUS OF SENATE MEMBERS RESIDING IN THE DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROVIDE FOR THE SELECTION OF SENATE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AND THE LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-301(a)(1), relating to the selection of Senate members of the Legislative Council, is amended to read as follows:

(1)~~(A)~~ The Senate of the General Assembly shall select ~~some time before adjournment of each regular session twelve (12) members, with three (3) members to be chosen from each of the four (4) congressional districts of the state in effect on January 1, 1987, by caucus of the members of the Senate residing in their respective congressional districts.~~

~~(B) Provided, however, after January 1, 1999, the twelve (12) members selected by the Senate shall be selected~~ sixteen (16) members in

1 accordance with procedures prescribed by Senate Rules;

3 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-403(a)(1)(A), relating to selection of
4 Senate members of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, is amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (A) Sometime before adjournment of each regular session, the Senate
7 shall select ~~twelve (12)~~ sixteen (16) members, with ~~three (3)~~ four (4) to be
8 chosen from each of the four (4) congressional districts in effect on January
9 1, 1987, by caucus of the Senators residing in their respective congressional
10 districts.
