Upon payment of the fee required by law for the registration 8 of the vehicle, payment of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to cover the design 9 use contribution, and payment of an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) handling and administrative fee for the issuance of the special Committed to Education 10 11 plate, the Department of Finance and Administration shall issue to the vehicle owner a Committed to Education license plate which shall bear the approved 12 13 design. The handling and administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be deposited to the State Central Services Fund for the benefit of the Revenue 14 15 Division and shall not be considered or credited to the Revenue Division as 16 "direct revenues". The design use contribution of twenty-five dollars 17 (\$25.00) shall be deposited in the Committed to Education Fund to be used by the Arkansas Committed to Education Foundation for the purpose of establishing 18 19 a program for elementary age children to recognize and reward academic and 20 character achievement through technology-based incentives. 21 22 SECTION 4. Special Committed to Education license plates issued under 23 this act may be renewed annually in accordance with the procedures set out in 24 Section 3 of this act and pursuant to Arkansas Code §§ 27-14-1012 and 27-14-25 1013. Registration may continue from year to year as long as it is renewed 26 each year within the time and manner required by law. A motor vehicle owner 27 who was previously issued a plate with the Committed to Education design 28 authorized by this act and who does not pay a design use contribution of 29 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to the subsequent time of registration shall be 30 issued a new plate which does not bear the Committed to Education design. Upon expiration, or if the special Committed to Education license plate is 31 32 lost, it may be replaced with a regular license plate at the fee specified in 33 § 27-14-602(b)(6). If the special Committed to Education license plate is 34 replaced with a new Committed to Education license plate, the owner shall be 35 required to pay the additional administrative cost of issuance as set forth in

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6	SECTION 6. The Special Committed to Education License plates shall		
7	comply with all other state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and		
8	licensing of motor vehicles except as herein specifically provided.		
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10	SECTION 7. The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration		
11	shall promulgate such reasonable rules and regulations and prescribe such		
12	forms as he determines to be necessary for effectively and efficiently

15	SECTION 8. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE</u> . It is found and determined by the General		
16	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that in order for technology incentives to		
17	be more readily available to Arkansas students meeting Committed to Education		
18	Foundation program criteria, the immediate passage of this act is required.		
19	The proceeds resulting from sales of Committed to Education license plates is		
20	critical to ensuring the timely reward and recognition of these outstanding		
21	elementary students and immediate passage of this act allows the program to be		
22	implemented and administered without delay. Therefore, an emergency is		
23	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the		
24	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on		
25	the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor		
26	vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the		
27	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is		
28	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective		
29	on the date the last house overrides the veto.
