Arkansas Code Annotated § 5-71-227 is hereby repealed. 26 5-71-227. Possessi on of paging device, etc., by students. 27 (a) It shall be unlawful for an individual enrolled as a student in a public or private elementary or secondary school or for any individual 28 29 eighteen (18) years of age or younger to possess an electronic paging device, beeper, or similar communications device while on property owned by a public 30 31 or private elementary or secondary school. (b) Violation of this section shall be a Class C misdemeanor. It shall 32 33 be a defense to prosecution under this section that the individual in possession of the paging device, beeper, or similar communications device has 34 35 been granted an exemption to possess such device by the board of directors of 36 the school or school board in which such individual is enrolled as a student.
