 - (3)(A) Effective July 1, 1997, the annuities of those members who chose early retirement when the years of service required for an unreduced annuity was thirty-five (35) or more years shall be adjusted to reflect the amount for which they would have been entitled had the number of years to retire with an unreduced annuity been thirty (30) years on the effective date of their retirement.

 10 retirement from July 1, 1995, through June 30, 1999, who received an early
 11 annuity as provided in § 24-7-702 which was in effect at the time of their
 12 retirement shall be adjusted effective July 1, 1999, to reflect a percent of

 - (4) The adjustments described in subdivision (b)(3) of this section shall not be retroactive to the effective date of the member's retirement.

SECTION 2. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO CODIFY THIS SECTION.] No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be implemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system's unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be implemented by any publicly supported system which has unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.
