19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 21-8-801 is amended to read as follows:

22 21-8-801. Prohibited acts generally.

23 No public servant who is required to file a statement of financial
24 interest under § 21-8-701(a), employee of a legislative branch, or employee of
25 a constitutional officer shall:

26 (1) Receive a gift or compensation as defined in subchapter 4 of this
27 chapter, other than income and benefits from the governmental body to which he
28 or she is duly entitled, for the performance of the duties and
29 responsibilities of his or her office or position;

30 (2) Purposely use or disclose to any other person or entity
31 confidential government information acquired by him or her in the course of
32 and by reason of the public servant's official duties, to secure anything of
33 material value or benefit for himself or herself or his or her family.
