15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS SUPREME COURT -
16 BIENNIAL OPERATIONS APPROPRIATION FOR
17 THE 2001-2003 BIENNIUM.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Arkansas Supreme Court for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
26 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
27 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
28 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
29 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
33 successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Supreme Court for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Supreme Court, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Supreme Court for

1 the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the following:

22 SECTION 4. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
 23 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
 24 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
 25 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
 26 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
 27 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
 28 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
 29 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
 30 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 31 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall
 32 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
 33 include the following:
 34 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
 35 expenditures on the fund balance.
 36 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or

- 1 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 2 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 3 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 4 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 5 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 6 depletion of the fund balance.
- 7 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 8 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought
- 9 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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11 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by

12 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made

13 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions

14 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures

15 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and

16 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this

17 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

19 with in disbursement of said funds.

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21 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint

28 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

32 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the

34 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the

35 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date

36 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

1 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
2 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
3 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
4 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.

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
