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29 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the 30 Office of the Governor for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum 31 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", 32 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary 33 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those 34 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, 35 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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1 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the 2 Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, 3 for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the Governor for 4 the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the following:

19 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 20 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER. Any 21 unexpended balance of appropriation provided in this Act, excluding Regular 22 Salaries, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000 23 <u>2002</u>, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for 24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001 <u>2003</u>.

25 <u>The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001</u>

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SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Agency is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized in Section 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Governor's Office in this Act to any other line item authorized in Section 3.

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2	SECTION 6. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED			
3	SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all			
4	appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall			
5	monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly			
6	basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to			
7	less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the			
8	disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.			
9	Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head			
10	shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State			
11	requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide			
12	sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the

Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 32 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 33 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 34 35 with in disbursement of said funds.

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1 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 8 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

11 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

12 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the

13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the

14 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the

15 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date

16 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

17 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an

18 <u>emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the</u>

19 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full

- 20 <u>force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.</u>
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
