AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-20-108(b)(3) TO
ALLOW FOR A ROAD TEST WAIVER FOR CERTAIN
MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE APPLICANTS; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-20-108(b)(3)
TO ALLOW FOR A ROAD TEST WAIVER FOR
CERTAIN MOTORCYCLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE
APPLICANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-20-108(b)(3), concerning operator's
examination for motorcycles, is amended to read as follows:

(3) An actual road test designed to determine the applicant's
familiarity with the controls of the motor vehicle and the applicant's ability
to safely operate the motor vehicle both in and out of traffic; However, the
road test shall be waived for applicants who have successfully completed the
Motorcycle Safety Foundation's Motorcycle Rider Course: Riding and Street
Skills or any successor curriculum. In order to qualify for this waiver, the
applicant must submit proof of the course completion dated within ninety (90)
days prior to the date of license application; and
