AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-8-106 TO GIVE THE
DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE
THE AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH A TOWING ROTATION LIST; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-8-106 TO
GIVE THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
ARKANSAS STATE POLICE THE AUTHORITY TO
ESTABLISH A TOWING ROTATION LIST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-8-106(a), concerning the Department of
Arkansas State Police duties and powers, is amended to read as follows:

(a) It shall be the duty of the Department of Arkansas State Police to:
(1) (A) Patrol the public highways, make arrests, and enforce the
laws of this state relating to motor vehicles and the use of the state
highways; and

(B) Establish, maintain and enforce a towing rotation list
to assist in clearing highways of motor vehicles which have been involved in
accidents or abandoned. The Director of the Department of Arkansas State
Police may promulgate necessary rules and regulations to carry out the purpose
and intent of this subdivision;

(2) Assist in the collection of delinquent motor vehicle license
taxes and the collection of gasoline and other taxes that are required by law;

and

(3) Determine when, if possible, the person or persons are the cause of injury to any such highway or other state property and arrest all persons criminally responsible for injury to any such highway or other state property and bring them before the proper officer for trial.
