For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-8-121(a) TO ALLOW MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO PERFORM OFF-DUTY SECURITY WORK AND WEAR THE ARKANSAS STATE POLICE UNIFORM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-8-121 (a) TO ALLOW MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS STATE POLICE TO PERFORM OFF-DUTY SECURITY WORK AND WEAR THE ARKANSAS STATE POLICE UNIFORM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-8-121(a), concerning use of the Arkansas State Police uniform, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) It shall be hereafter prohibited for any law enforcement agency, private security firm, corporation, partnership, or individual to wear a uniform in the same design and specific color scheme as the Arkansas State Police.

(2) Any certified law enforcement officer, who is a member of the Arkansas State Police, may perform security work or other law enforcement duties, while off-duty, for private security firms, corporations, partnerships or individuals, and may wear the Arkansas State Police uniform while performing those security or law enforcement duties, but may not use a Department of Arkansas State Police motor vehicle.
