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### **For An Act To Be Entitled**

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
10 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
11 - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES FOR THE  
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2003; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.  
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### **Subtitle**

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
17 - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS  
18 AND SCIENCES APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
19 2001-2003 BIENNIUM.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.  
26 There is hereby established for the Department of Education - Arkansas School  
27 for Mathematics and Sciences for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum  
28 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
29 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
30 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
31 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
32 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
33 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
34 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
35 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
36 successor.

1 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.  
 2 There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Arkansas School  
 3 for Mathematics and Sciences for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum  
 4 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
 5 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary  
 6 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those  
 7 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,  
 8 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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 10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.  
 11 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable  
 12 from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account, for personal  
 13 services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Arkansas  
 14 School for Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period ending June 30,  
 15 2003, the following:

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 30 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES -  
 31 CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be  
 32 payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department  
 33 of Education, for operating expenses of the Department of Education - Arkansas  
 34 School for Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period ending June 30,  
 35 2003, the following:

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular school term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as additional compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the following classifications:

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OUTREACH COORDINATOR PROVISION. In the event the Outreach Coordinator position established for the Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences is not able to secure funds for the school that either meets or exceeds the personal

1 services and operating expenses to support the position during the biennial  
2 period ending June 30, 2003, authorization for the position shall not  
3 continue.

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5 SECTION 7. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby  
6 appropriated, to the Department of Education - School for Mathematics and  
7 Sciences, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor  
8 fund or fund accounts, the following:

9 (A) For costs associated with construction, renovation, repair, major  
10 maintenance and the purchase of equipment, the sum of .....\$75,000.

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12 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. FUND TRANSFER. Any funds which remain in  
13 the Department of Education Public School Fund Account or the Public School  
14 Fund for the Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and  
15 Sciences at the end of a fiscal year shall be transferred by the Chief Fiscal  
16 Officer of the State to the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or  
17 fund accounts, there to be used exclusively to provide additional funding for  
18 appropriations for the Department of Education - Arkansas School for  
19 Mathematics and Sciences which are made payable from the General Improvement  
20 Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts.

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22 SECTION 9. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED  
23 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all  
24 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall  
25 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly  
26 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to  
27 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the  
28 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.  
29 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head  
30 shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State  
31 requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide  
32 sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the  
33 following:

- 34 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such  
35 expenditures on the fund balance.  
36 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or

1 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.  
2 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs  
3 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.  
4 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not  
5 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent  
6 depletion of the fund balance.  
7 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and  
8 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought  
9 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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11 *SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.* Disbursement of funds authorized  
12 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
14 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
15 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures  
16 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of  
17 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
19 with in disbursement of said funds.

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21 *SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.* It is the intent of the General Assembly  
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
28 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 *SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.* It is found and determined by the General  
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
32 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the  
34 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the  
35 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date  
36 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

1 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an  
2 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
3 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full  
4 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
