AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2001-2003 BIENNI UM.
be It enacted by the general assembly of the state of arkansas:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES. There is hereby established for the Department of Education. Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5.201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.


SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the 2001 - 2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period ending June 30 , 2003, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Education, for operating expenses of the Department of Education - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period ending June 30 , 2003, the following:

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular school term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as additional compensation an amount not to exceed \(1 / 12\) of their annual salary for each month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees. Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the following classifications:

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,2001 through June 30, 2003.
SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND temporary law. OUTREACH COORDINATOR PROVISION. In the event the Outreach Coordinator position established for the Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences is not able to secure funds for the school that either meets or exceeds the personal

services and operating expenses to support the position during the biennial
period endinglune 30, 2003, authorization for the position shall not
continue.
SECTION 7. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL I MPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - School for Mathematics and Sciences, to be payable from the General Improvement fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:
(A) For costs associated with construction, renovation, repair, major maintenance and the purchase of equipment, the sum of .............. \(\$ 75,000\).
SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. FUND TRANSFER. Any funds which remain in the Department of Education Public School Fund Account or the Public School Fund for the Department of Education. Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences at the end of a fiscal year shall be transferred by the Chief fiscal Of ficer of the State to the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, there to be used exclusively to provide additional funding for appropriations for the Department of Education. Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences which are made payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts.
SECTION 9. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund bal ances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent ( \(50 \%\) of the bal ance available on luly 1,2001 , the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal officer of the state requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide
sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the
following:
1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
expenditures on the fund balance.
2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
```

any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund bal ances will not Lepardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent depletion of the fund bal ance.
(B) The Chief Fiscal of ficer of the State shall review the request and approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought prior review by the Legislative Council.

SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Admi nistration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the of ficial minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on لuly 1,2001 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
