3	SECTION 13. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
4	SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
5	appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
6	monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
7	basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
8	less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
9	disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
10	Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
11	head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
12	State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall
13	provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
14	include the following:
15	1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
16	expenditures on the fund balance.
17	2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
18	any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
19	3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
20	<u>or one-time purchase of capitalized items.</u>
21	4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
22	jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
23	depletion of the fund balance.
24	(B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
25	<u>approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought</u>
26	prior review by the Legislative Council.
27	
28	SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
29	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
30	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
31	restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
32	Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
33	and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or
34	their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
35	applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
36	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in

1 disbursement of said funds.

2

SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 3 4 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 5 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 6 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 9 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 10

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12	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
16	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
17	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
18	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
19	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
20	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
21	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
22	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
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
