NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas may

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1 make special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport 2 in an amount not to exceed five ten thousand dollars (\$5,000) (\$10,000) per year for any one coach during each year of the 1999-2001 2001-2003 biennium. 3 4 Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, the 5 University of Central Arkansas shall report annually to the Legislative Joint 6 Auditing Committee the exact disposition of those special allowance funds. 7 8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 9 through June 30, 2003. 10 11 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 12 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BOOK STORE. If 13 the University of Central Arkansas cancels the current contract for operation of its book store and chooses to operate its book store with University 14 employees, the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is 15 16 allowed to utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this 17 Act, provided he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher 18 Education and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior 19 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council. 20 21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003. 22 23 SECTION 8. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED 24 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all 25 appropriations as <u>provided in this Act</u>, the agency disbursing officer shall 26 27 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly 28 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to 29 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 30 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 31 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency 32 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 33 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall 34 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall 35 include the following:

1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such

- 1 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 2 <u>2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or</u>
- 3 <u>any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.</u>
- 4 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 5 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 6 <u>4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not</u>
- 7 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 8 <u>depletion of the fund balance.</u>
- 9 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 10 <u>approve or disapprove all or any part of the request</u>, after having sought
- 11 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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13 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 14 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 15 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 16 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 17 18 Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their 19 successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and 20 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as 21 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said

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funds.

SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 33 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 35 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the

1	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
2	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
3	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
4	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
5	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
6	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
7	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
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
