12	(B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
13	approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought
14	prior review by the Legislative Council.

16	SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
17	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
18	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
19	restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
20	Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
21	and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or
22	their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
23	applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
24	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
25	disbursement of said funds.

27 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 33 34 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
4	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
5	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
6	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
7	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
8	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
9	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
10	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
