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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas*
25 *Code Revision Commission for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum*
26 *number of regular employees, the grades to be assigned to the respective*
27 *positions, and the maximum annual salaries for each such position. The*
28 *maximum annual salary for the position assigned to grades shall be determined*
29 *in accordance with, but shall not exceed the maximum annual amount for the*
30 *grade assigned herein, as established in Arkansas Code 21-5-209. Except for*
31 *the purpose of determining the maximum annual salary rate, which is to be*
32 *applicable to each of the positions to which a salary grade is assigned*
33 *hereinafter, in accordance with the provisions of Arkansas Code 21-5-209, all*
34 *positions set forth herein shall be exempt from other provisions of the*
35 *Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, but shall not*
36 *be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and*

1 *Restrictions Act, or its successor.*

13 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Code
 14 Revision Commission for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number
 15 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from
 16 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: *six (6)* temporary or part-time
 17 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for
 19 the appropriate classification.

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21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 22 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the State Central
 23 Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas
 24 Code Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the

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10 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE

11 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

12 AUTHORITY. The Arkansas Code Revision Commission may transfer appropriation

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SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. On July 1, 2001 any remaining fund balance in the Arkansas Code Revision Fund shall be transferred to the State Central Service Fund as direct revenue for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission.

SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER OF ALLOCATION. Funds allocated for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission from the State Administration of Justice Fund shall be transferred or deposited into the State Central Services Fund as direct revenue for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, in lieu of transfer or deposit for the Arkansas Code Revision Fund.

SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUDGET SAVINGS TRANSFER. (a) Due to savings from receiving free sets of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated, each Agency or Officer shall transfer or deposit the following funds and appropriations each fiscal year of the 2001-2003 biennium to the Arkansas Code Revision Commission:

 12 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary adjustments
 13 on his books and the books of the Auditor of the State for the transfer or
 14 deposit of the funds from each Officer or Agency as listed herein to Section 4
 15 of this Act as direct revenue to the State Central Services Fund for each
 16 fiscal year of the 2001-2003 biennium for the Arkansas Code Revision
 17 Commission.

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19 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 20 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GENERAL REVENUE
 21 TRANSFER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and State Treasurer shall
 22 transfer the sum of three hundred sixty thousand nine hundred and twenty seven
 23 dollars (\$360,927) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, and three hundred
 24 seventy five thousand four hundred and sixty four dollars (\$375,464) for the
 25 fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, from the State General Services Fund Account
 26 to the State Central Services Fund as a direct revenue for the Arkansas Code
 27 Revision Commission there to be used for such purposes as appropriated in
 28 Section 3 herein.

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30 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CODE
 32 REVISION COMMISSION OVERSIGHT. (a) The Director of the Bureau of Legislative
 33 Research, or a Bureau employee designated by the Director, shall be the
 34 disbursing officer for the funds appropriated by this act.

35 (b) The Director, or a Bureau employee designated by the Director, shall
 36 maintain all personnel records of the Commission.

1 (c) When the Director contracts for an audit of the Bureau, he or she shall
2 include in the contract a financial audit of the commission with a
3 proportional cost to be borne by the Commission except that the Bureau shall
4 bear the cost in excess of funds available to the Commission for that purpose.

5 (d) By September 1st of each year, the Director, or a Bureau employee
6 designated by the Director, shall evaluate the staff of the Code Revision
7 Commission, reporting any problems to the Code Revision Commission.

8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
9 through June 30, 2003.

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11 SECTION 13. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
12 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
13 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
14 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
15 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
16 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
17 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.

18 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
19 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
20 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall
21 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
22 include the following:

- 23 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
24 expenditures on the fund balance.
25 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
26 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
27 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
28 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
29 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
30 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
31 depletion of the fund balance.

32 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
33 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
34 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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36 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
3 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
4 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
5 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
6 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
7 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
8 with in disbursement of said funds.

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10 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
17 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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19 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
23 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
24 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
25 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
26 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
27 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
28 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
29 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
