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(a) All money received under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid to the Treasurer of State, who shall place this money to the credit of the Boiler Inspection Division, Department of Labor Special Fund and the salaries and expenses of operating the division shall be paid therefrom there to be used by the Department of Labor in carrying out the functions, powers and duties as set out in this chapter and to defray the costs of the maintenance, operation and improvements required by the Department of Labor in carrying out the functions, powers and duties otherwise imposed by law on the department or the Director of the Department of Labor.

(b) The <u>Chief Inspector of the Boiler Inspection Division</u> <u>Director of the Department of Labor</u> is authorized to issue vouchers for salaries and expenses of the division when proper appropriation has been made for the expenditures.

SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 11-6-103(e), concerning penalties for child labor violations, is amended to read as follows:

(e) Sums collected under this section shall be paid into the general fund of the State Treasury Department of Labor Special Fund.
