## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE WORKERS' COMPENSATI ON LAWS CONCERNI NG THE PROCEEDINGS ON CLAIMS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
```

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 11-9-704(c), concerning evidence and construction in proceedings for claims, is amended to read as follows:
(c) Evidence and Construction. (1) (A) (i) At the hearing the claimant and the employer may each present evidence in respect of the claim and may be represented by any person authorized in writing for such purpose.
(ii) The evidence may include verified medical reports which shall be accorded such weight as may be warranted from all the evidence of the case.
(B) Any determination of the existence or extent of physical impairment shall be supported by objective and measurable physical or mental findings.
(2) When deciding any issue, administrative law judges and the commission shall determine, on the basis of the record as a whole, whether the party having the burden of proof on the i ssue has established it by a preponderance of the evidence.
(3) Administrative I aw judges, the commission, and any reviewing

courts shall construe the provisions of this chapter strictly.
    (4) In determining whether a party has met the burden of proof on
an i ssue, admi nistrative law judges and the commi ssion shall weigh the
evidence i mpartially and without giving the benefit of the doubt to any party.
