(a) There is created in the First Judicial District an 20 additional circuit judgeship, which shall have jurisdiction in law, equity, 21 and probate. 22 (b) As soon as possible after the effective date of this act, the 23 Governor shall appoint a qualified person to temporarily fill the First Judicial District circuit judgeship created by this act, and the appointed 24 person shall serve until December 31, 2002, or until a successor has been 25 26 elected and qualified, whichever occurs last. (c) The qualified electors of the district shall elect the additional 27 circuit judge created by this act at the November, 2002, General Election, to 28 take office on January 1, 2003. The additional judge shall be elected from 29 30 the district and shall satisfy the same qualifications for holding office and 31 shall receive the same salary, expenses, and other allowances as provided by law for judges of the circuit courts. The judge shall serve for elected terms 32 33 of six (6) years. (d) The counties which comprise the First Judicial District shall 34 35 provide courtroom and office facilities and supplies for the judge of the circuit judgeship created by this act, which shall be paid out of the county 36

2	funds appropriated by the respective quorum courts of the counties for such
3	purposes.
4	(e) There shall be provided for the judge of the circuit judgeship
5	created by this act a court reporter and a trial court administrative
6	assistant whose salaries shall be fixed and paid in the manner provided by law
7	for court reporters and trial court administrative assistants of the circuit
8	courts of this state.
