18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-32-101 is amended to read as follows:	
21	15-32-101. Land to be surveyed Boundaries to be ascertained before	
22	timber is cut.	
23	(a) Before any person who shall desire to cut and remove for the	
24	purpose of rafting, making railroad ties, piling, telegraph poles, staves	, or
25	sawing into lumber, any timber from any land in this state, unless the la	nd
26	has been surveyed and the boundaries thereof ascertained and known, before	е
27	cutting and removing the timber, they shall: procure the county surveyor	of
28	the county in which the land may be situated and	
29	(1) cause Cause the land to be surveyed by the surveyor and	the
30	metes and bounds of the land shall be marked and plainly established—; or	
31	(2) Rely in good faith on an existing marked line or establish	<u>shed</u>
32	corners; or	
33	(3) Acquire a document signed by the landowner selling the t	
34	and the adjoining landowners, indicating that the landowners agree on the	
35	location of the boundary.	
36	(b) This section shall apply to persons purchasing timber rights f	r om

lands of this state as well as to landowners.

- (c) The provisions of this section are not intended to repeal or in any manner interfere with the provisions of Acts 1883, No. 83.
- (d) Any person who shall be found guilty of a violation of the provisions of this section shall be deemed to have committed a misdemeanor and shall be fined, for each offense, in any sum not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300) and may be imprisoned in the county jail not more than six (6) months.
- (e) This section shall not apply to the cutting and removing of timber by a public utility or its contractors for the purpose of constructing or maintaining a right-of-way.
