12 DALLAS COUNTIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

19 APPROPRIATION.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN CLEVELAND AND DALLAS
26 COUNTIES. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and
27 Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General
28 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

29 (A) For state support for the Kingsland Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
30 of \$5,000.

31 (B) For state support for the New Edinburg Fire Department, the sum of ...
32 \$5,000.

33 (C) For state support for the Ri son Volunteer Fire Department, the sum of
34 \$5,000.

35 (D) For state support for the Y Community Volunteer Fire Department, the
36 sum of \$5,000.

1 (E) For state support for the Carthage Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
2 of \$5,000.

3 (F) For state support for the Cooter Neck Fire Department, the sum of
4 \$5,000.

5 (G) For state support for the Manning Volunteer Fire Department, the sum of
6 \$5,000.

7 (H) For state support for the Holly Springs Fire Department, the sum of ..
8 \$5,000.

9 (I) For state support for the New Hope Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
10 of \$5,000.

11 (J) For state support for the Ouachita Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
12 of \$5,000.

13 (K) For state support for the Sparkman Fire Department, the sum of
14 \$5,000.

15 (L) For state support for the Temperance Hill Volunteer Fire Department,
16 the sum of \$5,000.

17 (M) For state support for the Tulip - Princeton Volunteer Fire Department,
18 the sum of \$5,000.

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20 SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
21 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
22 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
23 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
24 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
25 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
26 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
27 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
28 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
29 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
30 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
31 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

32 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
33 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
34 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
35 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
36 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any

1 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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3 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
10 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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12 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
16 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
17 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
18 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
19 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
20 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
21 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
22 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
