24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code *6-63-309(c)*, pertaining to academic personnel
27 recruitment and exceptions to maximum salary levels, is amended to read as
28 follows:

29 (c) In order that exceptionally well-qualified non-academic, non-
30 classified personnel may be recruited and retained, each state-supported
31 institution of higher education may exceed the maximum salary levels by no
32 more than twenty-five percent (25%) for no more than six percent (6%) of the
33 positions authorized in its biennial operations appropriation act for non-
34 academic, non-classified personnel, provided that amounts paid in excess of
35 the maximum salary levels for the personnel shall not exceed two and six
36 tenths percent (2.6%) of the aggregate appropriated for the personnel costs

1 during the preceding fiscal year for the institution.

2 (d) Subsection (c) of this section shall not apply to athletic
3 directors and coaches.

4 (d) Subsection (c) of this section shall not apply to coaches.
