19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-19-106, concerning open public meetings,
22 is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

23 (d)(1) A meeting may be closed to the public for the purpose of
24 discussing the purchase, sale, or lease of real property.

25 (2) However, the closed meeting may be attended by
26 representatives of the news media under the following conditions:

27 (A) The representative and his or her employer must not
28 have a financial interest in the purchase, sale, or lease of the property;

29 (B) The information obtained in the closed meeting shall
30 be confidential and shall not be made public until:

31 (i) The agency has executed a contract for the
32 purchase, sale, or lease of the property;

33 (ii) The agency makes the information public or
34 waives its right to keep the information confidential; or

35 (iii) The expiration of a period of one (1) year
36 from the date of the closed meeting; and

1 (C) The representative files a statement with the agency stating
2 that:

3 (i) To the best of his or her knowledge, the
4 representative and the employer do not have a financial interest in the
5 purchase, sale, or lease of the property; and

6 (ii) He or she will comply with the confidentiality
7 requirements of this section.
