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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - EXPANSION OF CURRENT LABORATORY OPERATIONS.
26 There is hereby established for the State Crime Laboratory for the 2001-2003
27 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
28 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
29 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and
30 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
31 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
32 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
33 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
34 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
35 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - EXPANSION OF CURRENT LABORATORY OPERATIONS.
 There is hereby appropriated, to the State Crime Laboratory, to be payable from the State General Services Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the State Crime Laboratory - Expansion of Current Laboratory Operations for the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the following:

SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASE. The State Crime Laboratory is authorized to purchase Motor Vehicles from the Capital Outlay line item authorized in Section 2 of this

1 Act. The total cost associated with the purchase of Motor Vehicle's
 2 including the payment of sales tax from the Capital Outlay line item shall
 3 not exceed \$122,600 during the biennial period ending June 30, 2003.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 5 through June 30, 2003.

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 7 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 8 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 9 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 10 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 17 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 18 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 19 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 20 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 21 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 23 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 24 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 26 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 27 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 28 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
 29 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of
 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 32 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the
 33 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 34 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 35 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 36 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.

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
