Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

24 <u>SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u> 25 <u>Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the</u>

27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
