Local boards - Appointment or election of members. 28 29 (c)(1) If Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, the local community college board chooses to remain an elected board, beginning 30 31 with the 1996 general election, the qualified electors of a community college district having a ten percent (10%) or greater population in any one (1) 32 33 racial minority, as reported by the most recent federal decennial census information, shall elect the members of the local board as follows, utilizing 34 35 selection procedures in compliance with the federal Voting Rights Act of 36 1965, as amended:

1	(A) At least ninety (90) days before the election, the
2	local board shall, with approval of the county board of election
3	commissioners of any county in which the community college is located, divide
4	the district into nine (9) zones, or the local board may, by resolution,
5	utilize existing quorum court districts. Zones shall have substantially equal
6	population, with boundaries based on the most recent available federal
7	decennial census information;
8	(B) A candidate for election from a zone or a quorum court
9	district must be a qualified elector and a resident of the zone or district.

12	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-61-529 is amended to add an additional
13	subsection to read as follows:
14	(d) If division into zones for election purposes would not created a
15	voting zone with twenty percent (20%) or greater population in any one (1)
