9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 19-4-522 TO PERMIT THE
10 PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS BY AGENCIES TO BE SUBCLASSIFIED
11 AS AN OPERATING EXPENSE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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14 TO PERMIT THE PURCHASE OF UNIFORMS BY
15 AGENCIES TO BE SUBCLASSIFIED AS AN
16 OPERATING EXPENSE.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-522(d)(1) is amended by adding an
22 additional subdivision to read as follows:

23 (d) Maintenance and general operation may be further categorized into
24 the following subclassifications and the expenses thereof to be used according
25 to the subclassification:

26 (1) Operating Expenses. This subclassification shall entail the
27 following, but not necessarily be limited thereto:

- 28 (A) Postage, telephone, and telegraph;
- 29 (B) Transportation of commodities or objects;
- 30 (C) Printing;
- 31 (D) State-owned motor vehicle expenses;
- 32 (E) Advertising;
- 33 (F) Minor and major repairs;
- 34 (G) Maintenance contracts;
- 35 (H) Utilities and fuel;
- 36 (I) Insurance premiums, surety and performance bonds, and

- 1 association dues and memberships;
- 2 (J) Contractual services not otherwise classified;
- 3 (K) Consumable supplies, materials, and commodities;
- 4 (L) Books, publications, and newspapers;
- 5 (M) Court costs;
- 6 (N) Equipment not capitalized;
- 7 (O) Applicable petty cash reimbursements, laundry, and
- 8 taxes;
- 9 (P) Travel, subsistence, meals, lodging, transportation of
- 10 state employees or officials, and nonstate employees traveling on official
- 11 business; ~~and~~
- 12 (Q) Such other items of operating expense as shall be
- 13 provided by the appropriation act, or under reasonable rules, regulations, and
- 14 procedures issued by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State; and
- 15 (R)(i) Uniforms the agency requires its employees to wear
- 16 as part of the job.
- 17 (ii) Clothing items, purchased for its employees,
- 18 that are not required to be worn during working hours or are purchased for the
- 19 promotion of the agency shall not be subclassified as an operating expense;
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
