17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-5-205(e)(1)(B) is amended by adding the
20 following new subdivisions to reflect sources of income to the State Central
21 Services Fund to read as follows:

22 (xiv) Public defender attorney fees to be used solely to defray costs
23 for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission as set out in §5-4-303(i)(2)(A).

24 (xv) Public defender user fees to be used to defray the costs of the
25 public defender system, §16-87-213.
26

27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(10)(B), concerning sources of funds
28 for the State General Services Fund Account, is amended to read as follows:

29 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

30 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

31 ~~(ii) Those special revenues as set out in subdivision (125) of § 19-6-301 of~~
32 ~~the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-301 et seq.;~~

33 ~~(iii)~~ (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the various
34 agencies and programs funded from the State General Services Fund Account;

18 other programs approved by the federal government for which no appropriations

20 (3) Additional positions authorized under the provisions of § 19-7-502 must
21 be paid from ~~Comprehensive Employment and Training~~ Workforce Investment Act,
22 or its successor's, funds deposited in the State Treasury for that specific
23 ~~Comprehensive Employment and Training~~ Workforce Investment Act, or its
24 successor's, program as may be authorized through the provisions of this
25 subchapter or from federal, local, or private funds deposited in the State

20 SECTION 33. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED

21 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

22 RECYCLING FUND. Any appropriation approved by the 83rd General Assembly made

23 payable from the "Electronic Equipment Recycling Fund" is hereby made payable

24 from the "Computer and Electronic Recycling Fund".

26 SECTION 34. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by

27 the General Assembly that changes in the state's fiscal laws must take effect

28 at the beginning of the fiscal year and that if the current legislative

29 session is extended such that the 90 day period is later than July 1, 2001

30 such changes will not be timely. Therefore, an emergency is declared to

31 exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the

32 public peace, health and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2001.
