(3) If the arresting officer is a municipal law enforcement officer, one-half (1/2) of the fine shall be deposited in that municipal fund used for the purchase and maintenance of rescue, emergency medical, and law enforcement vehicles, communications equipment, animals owned or used by law enforcement agencies, life-saving medical apparatus, and law enforcement apparatus to be used for those purposes.

- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-314(c), concerning fines for failure to register a motor vehicle, is amended to read as follows:
- (c)(1) If the arresting officer is a state police officer, the fine shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund to be used for the purchase and maintenance of state police vehicles.
- (2) If the arresting officer is a county law enforcement officer, the fine shall be deposited in that county fund used for the purchase and maintenance of rescue, emergency medical, and law enforcement vehicles, communications equipment, animals owned or used by law enforcement agencies, life-saving medical apparatus, and law enforcement apparatus to be used for those purposes.
