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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28 SECTION 1. (a)(1) Any United States male citizen or immigrant who is
29 at least eighteen (18) years of age but less than twenty-six (26) years of age
30 shall be registered for United States Selective Service when applying to the
31 Department of Finance and Administration for the issuance or renewal of, or a
32 duplicate copy of:

33 (A) A driver's license;

34 (B) A commercial driver's license; or

35 (C) An identification card.

36 (2) This registration is in compliance with the requirements of

1 section 3 of the "Military Selective Service Act", 50 U.S.C. App. 451 et seq.

2 (b) The Department of Finance and Administration shall forward, in an
3 electronic format, the necessary personal information required for
4 registration of the applicants identified in this section to the Selective
5 Service System.

6 (c) The applicant's submission of the application shall serve as an
7 indication that the applicant has already registered with the Selective
8 Service or that he is authorizing the department to forward to the Selective
9 Service the necessary information for such registration.

10 (d) The department shall notify the applicant, on the receipt, that his
11 submission of the application for a license or identification card identified
12 in this section will serve as his consent to be registered with the Selective
13 Service System, if so required by federal law.

14 (e) The department shall attempt to enter into an agreement with the
15 Selective Service System to share the cost and data necessary to implement
16 this act.

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18 SECTION 2. [The Arkansas Code Revision Commission is not required to
19 codify this section.] This act becomes effective on January 1, 2002.
