23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-71-104 is amended to read as follows:

26 15-71-104. ~~Attorney General and prosecuting attorney~~ Counsel for the
27 commission.

28 ~~(a) The Attorney General shall be attorney for the commission.~~
29 ~~However, in cases of emergency the commission may call upon the prosecuting~~
30 ~~attorney of the district where the action is to be brought or defended to~~
31 ~~represent the commission until such time as the Attorney General may take~~
32 ~~charge of the litigation.~~

33 (a)(1) The Oil and Gas Commission may employ an attorney to provide
34 specialized professional services in matters requiring legal representation,

35 (2) However, any contract for legal representation shall be
36 subject to approval by the Attorney General who shall otherwise be attorney

1 for the commission.

2 (b) Any member of the commission or the secretary thereof shall have
3 power to administer oaths to any witness in any hearing, investigation, or
4 proceeding contemplated by this act or by any other law of this state
5 relating to the conservation of oil or gas.
