16 *AN ACT CONCERNING PARTICIPATION OF*

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-61-522 is amended to read as follows:*  
24 *6-61-522. Limitations on operations.*

25 *(a) No tax shall ever be levied or collected for the construction of*  
26 *dormitories, nor shall any community college construct, maintain, or operate*  
27 *any dormitory for the housing of students.*

28 *(b)(1) Participation of community colleges in intercollegiate athletic*  
29 *programs shall be limited to basketball, volleyball, and spring sports,*  
30 *except as provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection.*

31 *(2) Community colleges may participate in an intercollegiate*  
32 *football program provided state funds, either directly or indirectly, or*  
33 *funds derived from property taxes or student fees, are not expended to*  
34 *support the program.*

36 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-61-1108 is amended to read as follows:*

1           6-61-1108. Sports programs.

2           (a) Westark Community College's participation in intercollegiate  
3 *athletic programs shall continue to be limited to basketball, volleyball, and*  
4 *spring sports, except as provided in subsection (b) of this section.*

5           (b) Westark Community College may participate in an intercollegiate  
6 football program provided state funds, either directly or indirectly, or  
7 funds derived from property taxes or student fees, are not expended to  
8 support the program.
