## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE EXEMPTIONS TO THE FREEDOM  
10 OF INFORMATION ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

13 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE EXEMPTIONS TO THE  
14 FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-19-105(b), pertaining to exemptions under  
20 the Freedom of Information Act, is amended to add an additional subdivision  
21 read as follows:

22 (12) Materials, information, examinations and answers to  
23 examinations utilized by boards and commissions for purposes of testing  
24 applicants for licensure by state boards or commissions.

26 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 25-19-106(c), pertaining to executive  
27 sessions under the Freedom of Information Act, is amended add to add an  
28 additional subdivision to read as follows:

29 (5) Boards and commissions of this state may meet in executive  
30 session for purposes of preparing examination materials and answers to  
31 examination materials which are administered to applicants for licensure from  
32 state agencies. Boards and commission are excluded from this chapter for the  
33 administering of examinations to applicants for licensure.
