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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-79-703(b), regarding health insurance
24 coverage for medically necessary foods, is amended to read as follows:

25 (b) Every health insurance policy, contract, certificate, or health
26 care plan issued in this state by an insurance company, hospital medical
27 service corporation, or health maintenance organization, other than coverage
28 limited to expenses from accident only, specified disease, hospital indemnity,
29 Medicare supplement, long-term care, disability income, or other limited
30 benefit health insurance policies, whether an individual or group policy,
31 contract, certificate, or health care plan, which covers the insured and
32 members of the insured's family, shall provide coverage for amino acid
33 modified preparations, low protein modified food products and any other
34 special dietary products and formulas prescribed under the direction of a
35 physician for the therapeutic treatment of phenylketonuria. This benefit may
36 be subject to a deductible, copayments, coinsurance, or other patient cost-

1 sharing amounts required by the health plan.
