20	SECTION 2. The Arkansas Drug Abuse and Violence Prevention Task Force	
21	shall develop a model coordinated, comprehensive and cumulative curriculum	
22	for teaching drug abuse prevention and violence prevention in grades K-12 in	
23	the public schools.	
24	The task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the	
25	Governor and the Legislative Council on or before March 1, 2002, and shall	
26	cease to exist on that date.

28	SECTION 3. <u>Necessary staff assistance to the task force shall be</u>	
29	provided by one or more of the agencies represented on the task force, as may	
30	be agreed upon by the individuals designating members of the task force.	
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
