11	SECTION 3. The commission shall advise the Secretary of State and		
12	other governmental and private entities regarding ways to:		
13	(1) Recognize and highlight the lasting historical significance of the		
14	Louisiana Purchase as it relates to Arkansas's role as the initial point of		
15	the Louisiana Purchase survey through a series of educational, ceremonial,		
16	and public events;		
17	(2) Establish Arkansas as a leader in this event organization and to		
18	coordinate with other states willing to participate for a unified approach to		
19	<u>cel ebrati on;</u>		
20	(3) Design a framework of activities to highlight a year-long event;		
21	(4) Work with existing state agencies to develop educational		
22	materials, lesson plans and educational programming to be distributed to		
23	school s;		
24	(5) Educate children and adults about the impact of the Louisiana		
25	Purchase on history and heritage, economy, arts, sciences, culture and		
26	<pre>government;</pre>		
27	(6) Increase regional tourism around the Louisiana Purchase Historic		
28	State Park; and		
29	(7) Solicit contributions from foundations, granting agencies and		
30	others interested in leaving a lasting legacy of celebration and education		
31	through this event.		
32			
33	SECTION 4. The Secretary of State shall provide staff for the		
34	commission.		
35			
36	SECTION 5. (a) The commission may hold meetings and act at times and		

1	places as the Commission may find advisable to fulfill the requirements of	
2	this act.	
3	(b) The first meeting shall be held at the call of the Secretary of	
4	State.	
5	(c) The members shall not receive compensation for their work on the	
6	commission.	
7	(d) The minutes of the meetings and any reports of the commission	
8	shall be filed with the Secretary of State and provided to all interested	
9	organizations and agencies.	
10		
11	SECTION 6. The commission and its duties shall expire on December 31,	
12	<u>2003.</u>
