30	(2) The posting of	land is not a requi	rement under this section.
31	(b)(1) Any person who violates this section shall be deemed guilty of		
32	violation and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars		
33	(\$100) <u>CLass B misdemeanor</u> .		
34	(2) However, a violation of this section shall be a Class B		
35	misdemeanor Class A misdemeanor	if the property was	posted pursuant to the
