Arkansas Code 6-63-307 is amended to read as follows: 6-63-307. Salary restrictions - Penalties. 24 25 (a) No employee drawing a salary or other form of compensation from an 26 institution of higher education shall be paid an additional salary or receive 27 additional compensation other than reimbursement for actual expenses from that institution, or from any other agency or institution of higher 28 29 education, except upon written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and by the head of each agency or institution 30 31 that the work performed by the employee for the other agency or institution 32 of higher education does not interfere with the proper and required 33 performance of the employee's primary duties and that the combined salary payments from both agencies or institutions of higher education will not 34 35 exceed the larger maximum annual salary of the line item position authorized 36 for either agency from which the employee is to be paid.

- (b) Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by any agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less than three (3) years or until the employee shall repay to the state any sums received by such employee in violation of this section, together with interest at a rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.
- (c) Any compensation received by a faculty member an employee for participation in a noncredit seminar, conference, or convention sponsored by an institution of higher education that is paid from funds generated by such seminar, conference, or convention shall be excluded from the maximum salary restrictions provided for in § 6-63-303 and the salary restrictions provided for in this section.
