## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN ARKANSAS "RX" PROGRAM TO  
REDUCE PRESCRIPTION DRUG PRICES FOR RESIDENTS OF  
THIS STATE; TO UTILIZE MANUFACTURER REBATES AND  
PHARMACY DISCOUNTS; TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE  
GOVERNMENT TO ACT AS PHARMACY BENEFIT MANAGER IN  
ESTABLISHING REBATES AND DISCOUNTS ON  
PRESCRIPTION DRUGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN ARKANSAS RX  
PROGRAM TO REDUCE PRESCRIPTION DRUG  
PRICES FOR RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. This act establishes an Arkansas RX program to reduce  
prescription drug prices for residents of this state.
