20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-312, concerning State Crime Laboratory  
23 records, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

24 (c) All records, files, and information obtained or developed by the  
25 State Crime Laboratory pertaining to a capital offense committed by a  
26 defendant, who is subsequently sentenced to death for the commission of that  
27 offense, shall be preserved and retained until the defendant's execution.
