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14 AN ACT TO EXEMPT STUDENT DISCIPLINE
15 RECORDS FROM THE ARKANSAS FREEDOM OF
16 INFORMATION ACT.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 25-19-105(b), pertaining to examination and
22 copying of public records, is amended to read as follows:

23 (b) It is the specific intent of this section that the following shall
24 not be deemed to be made open to the public under the provisions of this
25 chapter:

- 26 (1) State income tax records;
- 27 (2) Medical records, scholastic records, and adoption records;
- 28 (3) The site files and records maintained by the Arkansas
29 Historic Preservation Program and the Arkansas Archeological Survey;
- 30 (4) Grand jury minutes;
- 31 (5) Unpublished drafts of judicial or quasi-judicial opinions and
32 decisions;
- 33 (6) Undisclosed investigations by law enforcement agencies of
34 suspected criminal activity;
- 35 (7) Unpublished memoranda, working papers, and correspondence of
36 the Governor, members of the General Assembly, Supreme Court Justices, Court

of Appeals Judges, and the Attorney General;

(8) Documents which are protected from disclosure by order or rule of court;

(9)(A) Files which, if disclosed, would give advantage to competitors or bidders; and

(B)(i) Records maintained by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission related to any business entity's planning, site location, expansion, operations, or product development and marketing, unless approval for release of such records is granted by the business entity.

(ii) Provided, however, this exemption shall not be applicable to any records of expenditures or grants made or administered by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission and otherwise disclosable under the provisions of this chapter;

(10) Personnel records to the extent that disclosure would constitute clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; and

(11)(A) The identities of law enforcement officers currently working undercover with their agencies and identified in the Arkansas Minimum Standards Office as undercover officers.

(B) Records of the number of undercover officers and agency lists are not exempt from this chapter.

(12) Discipline records of a student attending an educational institution.

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
