Arkansas Code 11-9-711(a), concerning review of orders and 26 awards by the full Workers' Compensation Commission, is amended to read as 27 follows: (a) Award or Order of Administrative Law Judge or Single Commissioner 28 29 - Review. (1) A compensation order or award of an administrative law judge or a single commissioner shall become final unless a party to the dispute shall, 30 31 within thirty (30) days from the receipt by him of the order or award, 32 petition in writing for a review by the full commission of the order or 33 award. (2) Any other party to the dispute may cross appeal by filing a 34 35 written petition for cross appeal within fifteen (15) days after the notice of appeal is filed in the office of the Workers' Compensation Commission, 36

1	except that in no event shall a cross appellant have less than thirty (30)
2	days from the receipt by him of the order or award within which to file a
3	notice of cross appeal.
4	(3)(A) The full commission may only review compensation orders
5	or awards for questions of law.
6	(B) The findings of fact made by the administrative law
7	judge or a single commissioner shall be conclusive and binding upon the full
8	commission, and the full commission may not reverse an order or award of an
9	administrative law judge or a single commissioner on an issue of fact unless
10	the full commission finds that the order or award is not supported by
11	substantial evidence of record.
12	
13	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 11-9-713(a), concerning modifications of
14	workers' compensation awards, is amended to read as follows:
15	(a)(1) Except where a joint petition settlement has been approved, the
16	Workers' Compensation Commission may review in accordance with § 11-9-
17	711(a)(3) any compensation order, award, or decision.
18	(2) This may be done at any time within six (6) months of
19	termination of the compensation period fixed in the original compensation
20	order or award, upon the commission's own motion or upon the application of
21	any party in interest, on the ground of a change in physical condition or
22	upon proof of erroneous wage rate.
23	(3) Upon the review, <u>if the full commission finds questions of</u>
24	law or that the order or award is not supported by substantial evidence of
25	record, the commission may make an order or award terminating, continuing,
26	decreasing, or increasing for the future the compensation previously awarded,
27	subject to the maximum limits provided for in this chapter.
