22 WHEREAS, Mr. Charles Austin Vines of Little Rock, Arkansas, died on
23 Wednesday, February 21, 2001 at the age of ninety-three years; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Vines, who was a graduate of the University of Arkansas at
26 Fayetteville College of Agriculture and Home Economics, was a former director
27 of the Arkansas Agricultural Extension Service and despite his age he went to
28 his office every day, either at the University of Arkansas Cooperative
29 Extension Service in Little Rock, or at the C. A. Vines 4-H Center in
30 Ferndale; and

32 WHEREAS, during his long and illustrious career in various agriculture
33 positions and organizations, Mr. Vines received many honorary awards
34 including the Superior Service Award presented by the U.S. Secretary of
35 Agriculture for his contribution to the modernization of the Arkansas
36 Agricultural Extension Service and for his notable contribution to national

1 agricultural extension work; the Distinguished Service Ruby Award presented
2 by Epsilon Sigma Phi, the National Honorary Extension Fraternity which award
3 is presented to the one person in the United States each year who has made
4 the most outstanding contribution to the growth and development of the
5 Extension Service and its objectives; the prestigious United States Air Force
6 American Spirit Award which is presented to one individual annually who
7 consistently supports and exhibits extreme patriotism and service to this
8 country; and numerous others; and

10 WHEREAS, while Mr. Vines will long be remembered for his many
11 accomplishments and his foresight, talents and ability to get things done, he
12 may be best remembered for his warm humor and his love for his fellowman,
