27	this State, but the entire nation; and

29	WHEREAS, the history of Arkansas is the history of Native Americans; and

31	WHEREAS, today's Native American inhabitants of this State represent a
32	variety of Indian people including the Cherokee, the Choctaw, the Quapaw, the
33	Caddo, and the Osage; and

35	WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the Arkansas General Assembly pause in its
36	deliberations during this Regular Session and dwell upon and ponder the
