## 8 **SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

9 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR  
10 SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
11 UNTIL 12:00 NOON, MAY 7, 2001; TO PROVIDE FOR  
12 RECESS OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT  
13 THE CLOSE OF BUSINESS ON APRIL 13, 2001; TO  
14 AUTHORIZE THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE  
15 AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,  
16 BY JOINT PROCLAMATION, TO RECONVENE THE GENERAL  
17 ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE 12:00 NOON, MAY 7,  
18 2001 FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING VETOES,  
19 CORRECTING ERRORS OR OVERSIGHTS, COMPLETING ITS  
20 WORK ON PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS, AND  
21 CONSIDERING THE NEED FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE  
22 REGULAR SESSION, OR TO ADJOURN THE EIGHTY-THIRD  
23 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ANY TIME BEFORE THAT DATE IF  
24 THEY DETERMINE THAT THERE IS NO NEED TO  
25 RECONVENE; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE GENERAL  
26 ASSEMBLY IS NOT RECONVENED OR ADJOURNED BEFORE  
27 12:00 NOON, MAY 7, 2001, THE REGULAR SESSION OF  
28 THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED  
29 SINE DIE ON THAT DATE.

32 TO PROVIDE FOR AN EXTENSION OF THE  
33 REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD  
34 GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO PROVIDE FOR A  
35 RECESS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

(1) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General Assembly of  
the State of Arkansas is hereby extended until 12:00 Noon, May 7, 2001;

(2) That the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General Assembly of  
the State of Arkansas shall enter into recess at the close of business on  
April 13, 2001, or at such earlier time as may be agreed upon by the Senate  
and the House of Representatives; and

(3) That the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of  
the House of Representatives may, by joint proclamation, reconvene the  
General Assembly at any time before 12:00 Noon, May 7, 2001, for the purpose  
of considering executive vetoes, correcting errors and oversights, completing  
its work on proposed constitutional amendments, and considering the need for  
further extension of the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General  
Assembly, or may adjourn the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General  
Assembly at any time before that date if they determine it is not necessary  
to reconvene. If the General Assembly is not reconvened or adjourned before  
12:00 Noon, May 7, 2001, the Regular Session of the Eighty-third General  
Assembly is hereby adjourned sine die on that date.
