21	WHEREAS, the cell phone industry has become one of the fastest growing
22	industries, and more and more people are using cell phone technology; and

24	WHEREAS, many reports have been issued warning of potential serious
25	health risk associated with cell phone use; and

27	WHEREAS, there are conflicting reports concerning such issues as whether
28	cell phone use may cause or increase the incidence of cancer, including brain
29	cancer; and

31	WHEREAS, it is prudent for the General Assembly to begin studying the
32	potential health risks of cell phone use by Arkansans.

35	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
