19	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
20	OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
21	ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

23	That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the
24	Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the
25	electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election
26	for Senators and Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon
27	at such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the
28	Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

30	SECTION 1. The General Assembly is hereby authorized to levy any new
31	taxes and increase any existing taxes as may be necessary to adequately fund
32	the public schools of this state.
