8 **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION**

9 PROPOSING TO AMEND AMENDMENT 73 TO THE ARKANSAS
10 CONSTITUTION TO INCREASE FROM THREE TWO-YEAR TERMS TO
11 SIX TWO-YEAR TERMS THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TERMS THAT
12 MAY BE SERVED IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND TO
13 INCREASE FROM TWO FOUR-YEAR TERMS TO THREE FOUR-YEAR
14 TERMS THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF TERMS THAT MAY BE SERVED
15 IN THE SENATE.

23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE
24 OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS
25 ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

27 That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the
28 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the
29 electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election
30 for Senators and Representatives, if a majority of the electors voting thereon
31 at such election, adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the
32 Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

34 § 2. Legislative Branch.

35 (a) The Arkansas House of Representatives shall consist of members to
36 be chosen every second year by the qualified electors of the several counties.

No member of the Arkansas House of Representatives may serve more than ~~three~~
six such two year terms.

(b) The Arkansas Senate shall consist of members to be chosen every
four years by the qualified electors of the several districts. No member of
the Arkansas Senate may serve more than ~~two~~ three such four year terms.

(c) Terms served in the House and Senate prior to the effective date of
this amendment shall be counted in calculating the number of terms served.
